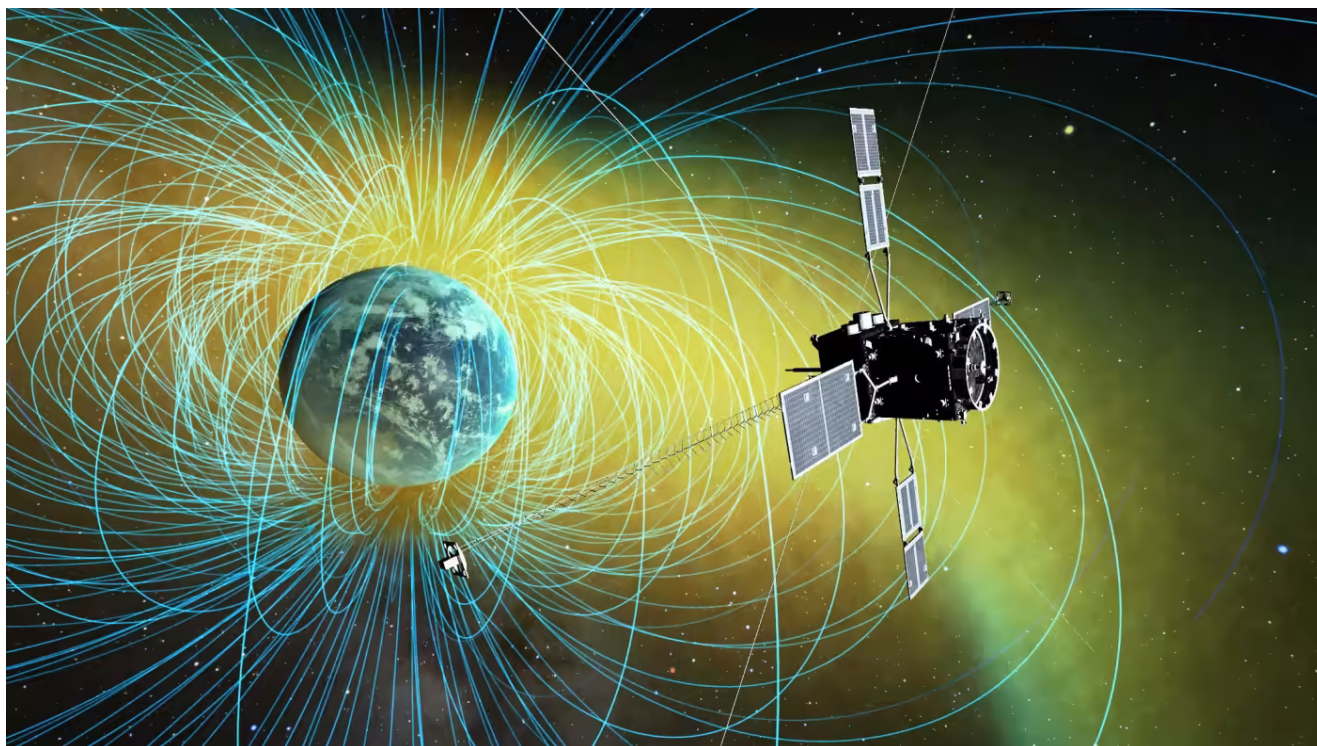
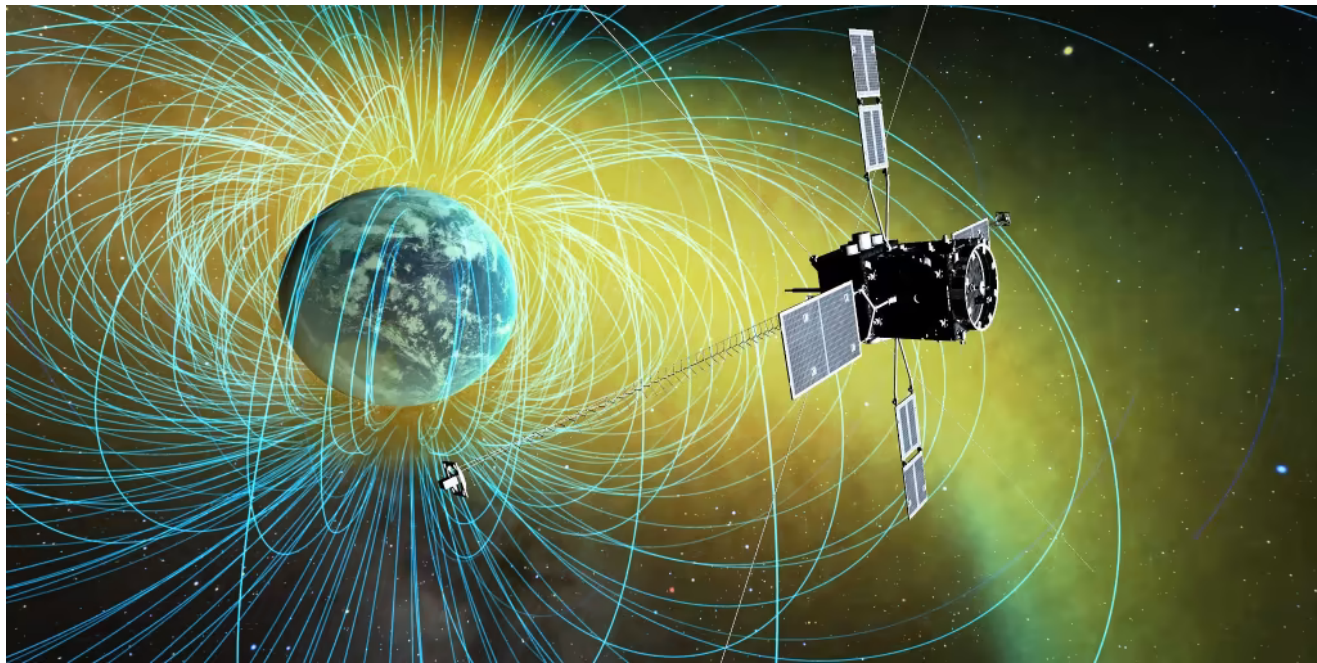


# Japan aerospace cyberattacks show link to Chinese military: police
